DESCRIPTION

Dodge Lip Wax is recommended for treating small discolorations, fever blisters, and parched, cracked, or dehydrated lip surfaces. It is formulated for application over the mucous membranes and may also be used in treating shallow wounds, or soft and moist tissue areas. Lip Wax seals blemished and desiccated surfaces, providing a base foundation for lip cosmetics. The Dodge Lip Waxes, when applied in a fine film, are a precaution against dehydration and separation.

FEATURES

Dodge Lip Wax is soft and pliable. It is not necessary to further soften it by the addition of massage cream or solvents. Lip Wax is available in three shades: Pink, Youthful, and Adult. Color matching can be accomplished by intermixing small quantities of Youthful and Adult shades with the Pink. This color mixing will allow you to duplicate the natural color of the lips – which means very little or no cosmetic will need to be applied over the waxed surface. If further treatment does become necessary, a cosmetic lip cream may be easily applied over the waxed lip surface to adjust the coloring and contour.

APPLICATION

Dodge Lip Wax is especially recommended for treating chapped, cracked, or fever-burned lips. During the pre-embalming treatments, the lip surfaces should be disinfected and heavily coated with White Kalon Massage Cream. Soft and oozing fever sores should be dried and preserved with a light cotton compress, saturated with Penetrating Dryene. Remove all scabs, lesions, and encrusted areas after the embalming treatments are completed. Allow ample time for the Dryene compress to preserve and firm the lip tissues (mucous membranes) before applying the Lip Wax. The lip surfaces should be smooth and level to insure the best results.
